

RESOLUTION NO. 3273

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT TO PURCHASE A
NEW PONTOON BOAT

WHEREAS, the City desires to acquire a replacement for its existing rowboat, because the existing boat is not safe for staff to use while working on equipment in the pretreatment lagoon; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department solicited and obtained three price quotations, and the lowest qualifying bid was by Pond King, Inc., for the amount of \$7,075.19 (exclusive of sales tax); and

WHEREAS, the quoted price is acceptable to City staff; and

WHEREAS, the existing boat will be retained until after the replacement boat is physically obtained, and the existing boat will then either be kept as a backup or will later be declared to be surplus and then disposed of in a commercially reasonable manner; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that good cause exists to proceed with this transaction;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SELAH, WASHINGTON, (a) that the Public Works Department be and is authorized to purchase and acquire a pontoon boat for a maximum price of \$7,075.19 (exclusive of sales tax) or any lesser amount that might prove possible; and (b) that the Public Works Director and/or his designee be and are authorized to sign any documents and to undertake any actions that are necessary to effectuate such purchase.
