Signs

Placement of signs is not allowed on utility poles within the City of Selah. SMC 10.38.050

Derelict/Inoperable Vehicles

Vehicles must have a current license tag, be equipped with all parts required to legally and safely operate on public streets, and can be driven under its own power.

Swimming Pools

Residential pools must be maintained and enclosed by a fence at least 4 feet high with self-closing or self-latching devices on gates or doors. Junk, Trash & Debris
Such items are prohibited from
being left in the yard and must
be disposed of properly.

Offensive Growth

Yard maintenance pertains to any untended growth in excess of 12 inches in height.
