ORDINANCE NO. 2184

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF SELAH, WASHINGTON, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2023

WHEREAS, the City council has considered the estimated revenues and appropriations required in budgeting and controlling the financial operations of the City for 2023 and has prepared a preliminary budget, published notices of hearings, and held public hearings as required by law;
