## RESOLUTION REVISING RATES FOR THE COLLECTION OF SOLID WASTE

WHEREAS, Section 3.02.080 of the Selah Municipal Code provides that rates for Solid Waste collection be set by resolution of the City Council from time to time, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that a revision in the Solid Waste Rate structure is appropriate:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SELAH, WASHINGTON, as follows:

The following rates are to be billed monthly by the City and paid by the residents and customers of the City:

Walk-in Service: \$0...

\$0.31 per foot round-trip per can per pickup.

Commercial locking container service: an additional charge of \$22.96 per month for a locking bin.

Roll out charge: If a driver is required to move a commercial container more than ten feet but less than twenty-five feet to the curb or alley line, an additional charge of \$6.60 per pickup will be assessed. An additional charge of \$3.84 per pickup will be assessed for each additional twenty-five-foot increment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SELAH, WASHINGTON that the rates for Solid Waste be adopted and that the rates set forth herein shall be effective commencing January 1, 2024.
