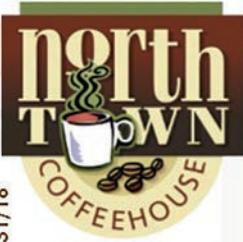

### PRESCHOOL 1:

Recommended for children with no experience in water. This level is to give children an introduction to the water with complete assistance. (ages 2-5)

### PRESCHOOL 2:

Recommended for children with little to no experience in the water and requires full time assistance. (ages 2-5)

### PRESCHOOL 3:

Recommended for children with some experience, but are comfortable learning new skills while trying to be independent. (ages 2-5)

## POOL RULES

1. Pool users must be at least 45' tall & able to swim or be supervised by an adult.
2. Only children, 5 years and younger, may use the splash pad. Splash pad users MUST be accompanied by an adult.
3. The pool may close due to inclement weather.
4. Swimming suits are required to swim. No denim!
5. Diving is NOT allowed.
6. Waterproof pull-ups are REQUIRED for infants and toddlers.
7. Outside toys or inflatables are PROHIBITED.
8. **NO OUTSIDE FOOD OR DRINKS.** Concessions allowed at picnic tables ONLY.

### LEVEL 1:

For beginners with little to no experience swimming. Basics will be taught with assistance. Safety skills will be introduced. (5+)

### LEVEL 2:

Beginning level class building upon the foundations learned in Level 1. This class works towards improving techniques involved with kicking, arm rotation, stamina and safety skills. (5+)

### LEVEL 3:

Level 3 is an intermediate class for children ready to perform swimming skills independently in deep water. This class improves confidence in techniques and swimming ability while improving stamina.

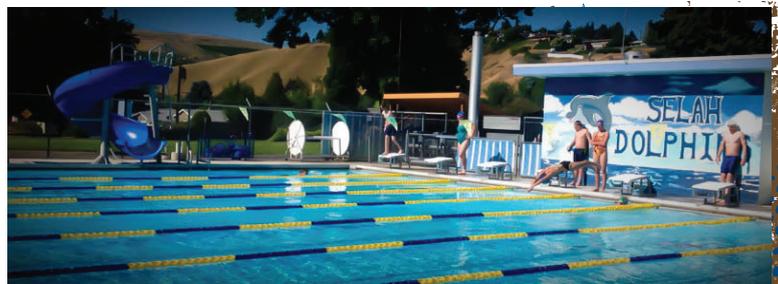
