TO REQUEST RELEASE OF FUNDS**

TO ALL INTERESTED AGENCIES, GROUPS AND PERSONS

On or about February 17, 2015, the City of Selah will request the State of Washington Department of Health and Department of Commerce to release funds under Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act, National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), and Washington State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA).

City of Selah Public Works will undertake the project described below utilizing Drinking Water State Revolving Fund Loans. A Determination of No Historic Properties Affected was issued for this project. A SEPA Determination of Nonsignificance (DNS) was issued by the City of Selah for this project. A copy of the Project Review Sheet for Section 106 and SEPA determination is on file at 222 S. Rushmore Rd., Selah, WA 98942, (509) 698-7365 and is available for public examination and copying upon request.

Project Information: Third Street Water Main Replacement – DWSRF Project # DM13-952-130. The project consists of the replacement of approximately 2,100 linear feet of 6-inch cast iron water main with new 12-inch water and all associated valves, fire hydrants, and water services. Yakima County at Township 13N, Range 18E, and Section 2. The estimated cost of the project is \$714,828

Objections of the project may be submitted to the Office of Drinking Water Director, Clark Halvorson, Department of Health; PO Box 47822; Olympia, WA 98504-7822. Any objections received after February 17, 2015 will not be considered by the Department of Health.
