PLEASE NOTE: Mover to notify Fire Dept., 698-7310; and the Police Dept., 698-7347; immediately prior to entering the street. The Selah Public Works Department will charge for time and materials to repair damage to City property and to follow the house move. ESCORT AND TRAFFIC CONTROL are the responsibility of the mover and shall be in accordance with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices. No moves shall take place on Saturday or Sunday. The City Public Works Department will not move any signals or signs in order for the move to take place. Mover may be charged for labor and materials by public utility companies that need to follow the move. Mover may be charged for labor and materials by public utility companies that need to repair/replace any damage due to the move. 48 hours notice is required for scheduling City and Public Utility crews for the move.

SPECIFICATIONS FOR REMOVAL OF STRUCTURES

Structures must be removed by a bonded licensed house moving Contractor and shall be insured for liability in the minimum sums of:

General Aggregate -	\$600,000
Products-Comp/ops Aggregate -	\$300,000
Personal & Advertising Injury -	\$300,000
Each Occurrence -	\$300,000
Fire Damage -	\$ 50,000

The moving Contractor shall name the City of Selah as an additional insured and provide proof of insurance to the City of Selah prior to removal.

1. All permits and licenses necessary for the performance of the work shall be secured and paid for by the Owner and/or moving Contractor.
2. The moving Contractor shall remove all debris and miscellaneous material created by the moving of the designated structure and disposed of such debris and miscellaneous material at a location provided by the Contractor.
3. The Contractor shall maintain adequate protection for employees and property in the performance of his or her work from damage and shall protect the Cities property from injury or loss arising in connection with this project. The Contractor shall reimburse or correct any such damage, injury or loss. The Contractor shall take all necessary precautions for the safety of employees on the work, and shall comply with all applicable provisions of federal, state and municipal safety laws and building codes to prevent accidents or injury to persons on, about and adjacent to the premises for the work that is being performed.

The Owner and/or Contractor shall agree to release, save, and otherwise hold harmless the City of Selah and it's employees from all claims, demand, damages, actions, causes of actions, or other liability injury or harm caused by act or omission foreseen or unforeseen, including hazardous materials, negligent or otherwise, that would otherwise default the City arising out of the contractor's implementation of the terms of this agreement.
