


RESOLUTION NO. 2517

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN AN
INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT WITH THE WASHINGTON STATE
PATROL FOR \$11,900 IN GRANT FUNDS FOR ELECTRONIC
FINGERPRINTING EQUIPMENT

WHEREAS, Washington State Patrol has awarded the City of Selah a grant of \$11,900, requiring a ten percent match, through the National Criminal History Improvement Program (NCHIP) for electronic fingerprinting equipment;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SELAH, WASHINGTON, that the Mayor be authorized to sign an Interagency Agreement with the Washington State Patrol for grant funds not to exceed \$11,900 to purchase electronic fingerprinting equipment per the requirements of NCHIP. A copy of said requirements is attached.
