**A RESOLUTION** declaring police service pistol surplus and authorizing disposition of the same as additional consideration for service provided.

**WHEREAS**, Officer Tony Valencia is being forced into retirement due to medical condition after having served on the City of Selah's Police for many years;

**WHEREAS**, Officer Valencia's service to the City has been exemplary;

**WHEREAS**, during Tony Valencia's service with the City he has carried a service pistol, a Glock Model 21 serial number PAU841;

**WHEREAS**, as additional consideration for Officer Valencia outstanding service to the City, the City's Police Department would like to surplus the service pistol Tony Valencia carried and provide it to Tony Valencia upon his retirement;



**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SELAH, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES as follows:**

**Section 1.** Police Service Pistol Glock Model 21 serial number PAU841 is hereby declared surplus.


**Section 2.** The City of Selah Police Department is authorized to transfer the Pistol to retiring Officer Tony Valencia in acknowledgment of and as additional consideration for his years of exemplary service to the City of Selah and its residents.
