

RESOLUTION NO. 2768

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CITY STAFF TO APPLY FOR A WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF ECOLOGY SHORELINE MASTER PLAN PERIODIC REVIEW GRANT, CONSULTANT SELECTION, AND AUTHORIZATION FOR THE MAYOR TO SIGN THE NECESSARY GRANT MATERIALS AND CONSULTANT CONTRACT TO COMPLETE THE CITY'S REQUIRED SHORELINE MASTER PROGRAM REVIEW.

WHEREAS, the City of Selah is required by the Washington State Shoreline Management Act (SMA) to review, and, revise their SMP by June 30, 2021 in accordance with RCW 90.58.080; and,


WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Ecology has established a grant in the amount of \$16,800.00 to assist the City of Selah in updating its Shoreline Master Program; and,

WHEREAS, City staff is requesting council authorization to apply for the Washington State Department of Ecology Shoreline Master Program Periodic Review Grant, and select a consultant to update the City's SMP; and,

WHEREAS, Council is also requested to authorize the Mayor to sign all required grant materials, and consultant contract to complete the city's required Shoreline Master Program Review.


