A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AUGUST 11, 2020 AS THE DATE TO CONDUCT A PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER THE PETITION AND VACATION OF A PORTION OF N. FIRST STREET RIGHT-OF-WAY LYING NORTH OF WEST BARTLETT AVE.


WHEREAS, the City of Selah has received a petition from Shane Backland of the Selah School District #119, the adjacent property owner, requesting the vacation of a portion of N. First Street right-of-way, lying N. of West Bartlett Ave. (more fully described in the applicant's application dated July 7, 2020); and,

WHEREAS, R.C.W. 35.79.010 requires the City by resolution fix a place, date and time when the petition will be heard and determined by the City, which time shall not be more than sixty (60) days nor less than twenty (20) days after the date of the passage of such resolution.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SELAH, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

That August 11th 2020 at 5:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as practical, in the Council Hearing Room, 115 W. Naches Avenue, Selah, WA. shall be set as the date, time and location of a public hearing to hear and decide said petition and that notice of said public hearing shall be provided as required by law.
