A **RESOLUTION** declaring police service weapon surplus and authorizing disposition of the same as additional consideration for service provided.

WHEREAS, Sergeant Bill Rodriguez is retiring after having served on the City of Selah's Police for many years; and,

WHEREAS, Sergeant Rodriguez' service to the City has been exemplary; and,

WHEREAS, during Sergeant Rodriguez' service with the City he has carried a service weapon, a Glock 21, serial number NYC394; and,

WHEREAS, as additional consideration for Sergeant Rodriguez' outstanding service to the City, the City's Police Department would like to surplus the service weapon Sergeant Rodriguez carried and provide it to Sergeant Rodriguez upon his retirement; and,


WHEREAS, the City of Selah wishes to surplus and provide the service pistol to Bill Rodriguez in acknowledgment of the exemplary service he provided to the City and as additional consideration for that service;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SELAH, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES as follows:

Section 1. Police Service weapon Glock 21 handgun, serial number NYC394 is hereby declared surplus.


Section 2. The City of Selah Police Department is authorized to transfer the Pistol to retiring Sergeant Rodriguez in acknowledgment of and as additional consideration for his years of exemplary service to the City of Selah and its residents.
