

RESOLUTION NO. 3126

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SIGNING AND SUBMISSION OF A WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (WSDOT) SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL FUNDING APPLICATION, SEEKING GRANT FUNDS FOR A SIDEWALK GAP PROJECT ON THE NORTH SIDE OF EAST HOME AVENUE

WHEREAS, there is currently no sidewalk on either side of East Home Avenue between North 1<sup>st</sup> Street and Wenas Road; and

WHEREAS, the City desires, and has long desired, to construct sidewalks on this portion of roadway and to obtain grant funds for use on such Project; and

WHEREAS, on April 12, 2022, the City Council passed Resolution No. 2906, which authorized HLA Engineering & Surveying, Inc. (HLA), to prepare and submit a Safe Routes to School Funding Application on the City's behalf seeking grant funds for this Project; and

WHEREAS, HLA did prepare and submit such Application, but, unfortunately, the City was ultimately not awarded any grant funds; and

WHEREAS, on February 27, 2024, the City Council passed Resolution No. 3095, which authorized City staff to prepare and submit a TIB Complete Streets Early Opportunity Funding Application seeking grant funds for this Project; and

WHEREAS, City staff did prepare and submit such Application, but, unfortunately, the City was not awarded any grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the City now desires to yet again apply for grant funds, by submitting a new Safe Routes to School Funding Application; and

WHEREAS, the total project cost is estimated to be \$578,120.00 based on HLA's cost estimate, and City staff is not expecting to obligate the City to contribute any matching funds; and

WHEREAS, the Selah School District has, as part of its Transportation Cooperative Project, provided \$20,200.00 into the City's Street Improvement Fund for use on this Project; and

WHEREAS, City staff seeks authorization for a new Application to be signed and submitted, and the City Council finds that good cause exists;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SELAH, WASHINGTON, that the Mayor, City Staff and/or HLA be and are authorized to sign and submit a new Safe Routes to School Funding Application seeking grant funds for this Project.
