## RESOLUTION NO. 3127

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN AN AGREEMENT WITH ASCENT FOUNDATIONS & MORE, LLC, RELATED TO THE EAST ORCHARD SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City desires to construct certain sidewalk improvements along the north side of East Orchard Avenue between North 1st Street and Wenas Road; and

WHEREAS, the City – with assistance by the City's retained engineering firm of Gray & Osborne, Inc. – solicited competitive sealed bids from interested contractors for such construction work, comparatively evaluated the received bids, and determined the lowest qualified bidder to be Ascent Foundations & More, LLC, of Cle Elum, Washington; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to award this scope of work to Ascent Foundations & More, and to enter into a construction contract for the overall total cost of \$133,230.22; and

WHEREAS, a written "Agreement" measuring five total pages (which pages are labeled Agreement, Public Works Performance Bond and Public Works Payment Bond, and will be part of a larger total package of contract documents which package will include the specifications, bid material, and other items) has been prepared, and the terms of the proposed Agreement are acceptable to City staff;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SELAH, WASHINGTON, as follows: (1) that the Mayor and/or Public Works Director be and are authorized to sign, and fill in the existing blank lines on, the five-page Agreement with Ascent Foundations & More, LLC, in the form appended hereto; (2) if an award letter and/or any other documentation proves necessary to effectuate awarding and/or receiving this scope of work, the Mayor and/or Public Works Director are likewise authorized to sign and/or prepare such; and (3) if it becomes possible for the City to obtain this scope of work for a lessor amount than currently contemplated, the Mayor and/or Public Works Director are authorized to enter into and/or sign any necessary agreements or documents without further approval by the City Council.
