

RESOLUTION NO. 3131

RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE CITY OF SELAH SIX-YEAR
TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FROM 2025 TO 2030

WHEREAS, state law requires that cities establish a comprehensive street program for the improvement of secondary and collector arterial streets within their respective corporal limits; and

WHEREAS, Selah desires to use revenues generated by the one-half cent (\$0.005) gas tax to make improvements to certain streets; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 35.77.010, Selah has prepared a transportation improvement program for the forthcoming six years, which is entitled "City of Selah Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program from 2025 to 2030"; and


WHEREAS, the City Council finds that good cause exists to adopt the TIP;
