NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SELAH, WASHINGTON that the Mayor, City Staff and/or HLA be and are authorized to sign and submit a Drinking Water State Revolving Fund Application for this Project.
